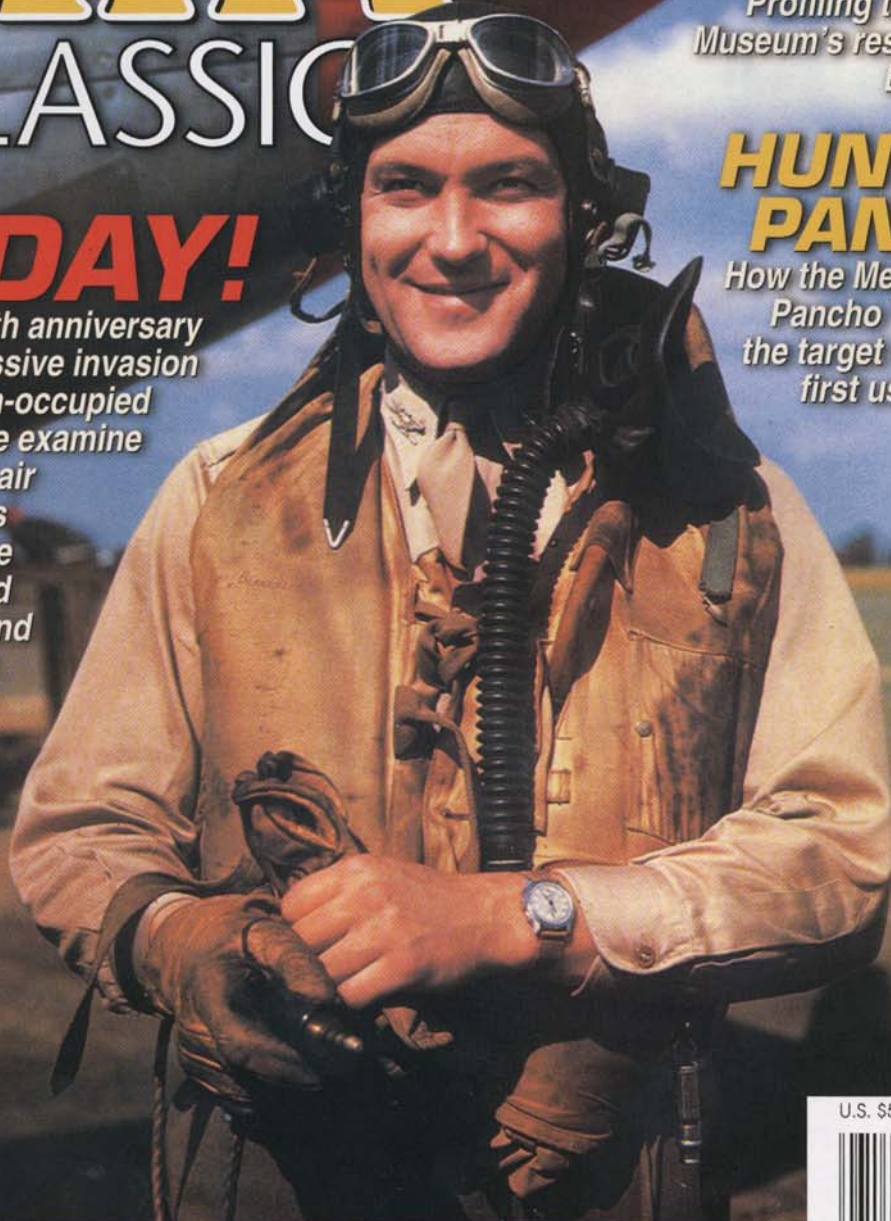

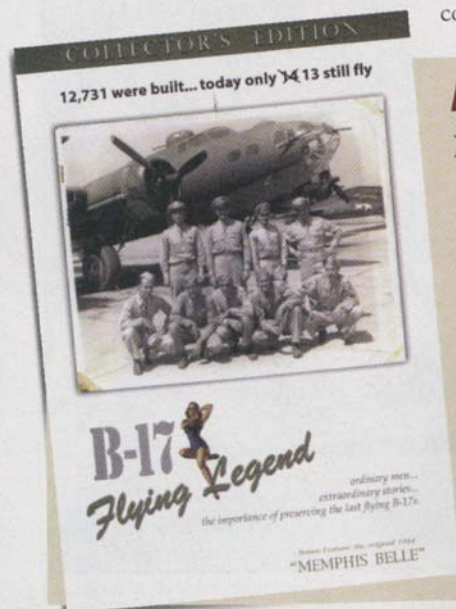

Delivering spies while flying captured Allied aircraft, clandestine reconnaissance missions over land and sea, testing new weapons such as the *Mistel* composite bomber and the piloted variant of the V-1, and extremely long-range liaison flights were just some of the tasks undertaken by KG 200.

There was also a sinister aspect to the unit's operations: Men from KG 200 played a significant part in the notorious action against the French Resistance on the Vercors plateau while others were involved in what were effectively suicide missions.

The well-produced book features 200 black and white photographs, most extremely rare, and 16 pages of nicely done color profiles. An essential item for the student of WWII history.



KEEPING THE FORTS FLYING

New DVD shows just what it takes

B-17 Flying Legend is a new DVD that is devoted to raising the awareness about the struggles of preserving the last operational Boeing B-17 Flying Fortresses while reliving the history behind these rare and magnificent airplanes and the men who flew them.

Following in the footsteps of William Wyler's documentary *Memphis Belle*, the DVD examines the almost folkloric tales of survival at 30,000-ft and 40-deg below zero. With never before seen WWII color footage and rare photographs, the DVD is an in-depth study of the last flying B-17s.

The DVD (which lists at \$24.95) contains numerous bonus features including the original 1944 *Memphis Belle* documentary, photo galleries with over 200 historic shots, footage of the last flying B-17s, a B-17 virtual tour, original pilot's notes, and others.
